INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC



CATEGORY A: PERFORMING ARTS / UITVOERENDE KUNSTE SUBJECT: MUSIC / MUSIEK

ENTRANTS MUST COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. <u>Entries are limited to THREE (3)</u> items per person in certain sessions. Please check the individual sessions for guidance.
- 2. <u>Entrants ARE NOT REQUIRED TO INCLUDE A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC WITH THE ENTRY FORM, BUT ARE REMINDED TO</u> <u>SUBMIT A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC TO THE ADJUDICATOR SECRETARY ON THE DAY OF PERFORMANCE. This copy may</u> <u>not be returned.</u>
- 3. There are no program requirements of solo classical repertoire in any of the classes with the exception that no works requiring any sort of preparation or amplification of the piano (s) will be admitted.
- 4. Candidates should observe da capo and dal segno indications, but other repeats of more than a few bars should not be played.
- 5. Pieces performed must be complete, as well as complete movements of larger works. No "cuts" or "excerpts" will be allowed, for example: the Exposition section of a Haydn, Mozart or Beethoven Sonata is NOT the whole movement. The whole movement of such a piece must be performed. It is not required to perform a complete Sonata; however, it is allowed for example when a teacher or candidate wishes to enter such a large-scale work it must be entered as follow:
 - i. L. Beethoven Sonata Op 90 (complete) or
 - ii. L. Beethoven Sonata Op 90 (1st Movement)
- 6. Works from the Examination Syllabi of ABRSM, TRINITY, UNISA and other examination bodies are allowed.
- 7. <u>TEACHERS should refrain from entering a huge group of candidates that play the same piece over and over on the same</u> instrument.
- 8. Candidates must tune their instruments themselves at all grades. However, the teacher or accompanist may advise on tuning for Grades 1-5, if needed.
- 9. The Art Festival provides music stands, but candidates are welcome to bring their own if they prefer.


Closing date for all entries in this category is on Monday 24 June 2019.

VERY IMPORTANT: PLEASE ENSURE THAT WE RECEIVE YOUR ENTRY FORMS ON THE ABOVE DATE OR A MAXIMUM OF TWO – THREE DAYS LATER. WE MUST RECEIVE ENTRIES BEFORE THE JUNE HOLIDAYS. WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT? DURING THE JUNE HOLIDAYS, ALL ENTRIES ARE SIEVED INTO CORRECT SESSIONS IN ORDER FOR US TO DO A NUMBER OF THINGS:

- 1. To compile the venue and time allocation time table.
- 2. To determine the number of entries and time needed to process the various sessions.
- 3. To inform adjudicators of their time table and compile sessions according to availability.
- 4. To assist schools with transport problems.

- 5. To accommodate all requests received from schools and parents.
- 6. To compile the master list for the diplomas which are sent to the printers.
- 7. To check that the names and surnames of all candidates are correct on the diplomas.
- 8. To determine the precise outlay of the venues.
- 9. To submit orders for notarial seals, medals, trophies etc. timeously to the various companies.

ALL MUSIC TEACHERS: please do not annoy the audience, or the adjudicators by entering candidates that play the same piece over and over on the same instrument. As musicians, we are very privileged to have such a vast choice of repertoire for almost every available instrument. The choices are endless.

MUSIC: INSTRUMENTAL SESSION A1 ALL BEGINNERS OPEN SESSION: ALL INSTRUMENTS SOLO

A <u>beginner</u> in this session is understood, a learner that has not yet reached the general music requirements as set forth by the various examination authorities for Grade 1. *Please do not show additional details for example 1st year or 2nd year on the entry form. It is irrelevant. The learner entered in this session is still considered a BEGINNER as this section makes no distinction between 1st or 2nd year. ALL CANDIDATES IN THIS SESSION, IRRESPECTIVE OF THEIR AGE, ARE ADJUDICATED AS BEGINNERS IN MUSIC.*

SESSION: A1 (GENERAL)

- This session focus on <u>ALL BEGINNERS</u> in <u>ANY SOLO</u> instrument except pipe organ. (for organ, see the ORGAN category)
- Candidates to provide their own instruments (other than piano).
- □ Candidates to provide their own accompanists (if necessary).
- ♫ Maximum time limit per piece: 1 minute and 30 seconds
- Choice of work: Own choice
- THREE (3) pieces per instrument may be submitted but candidates are reminded that it should be done on separate entry forms and the appropriate entry fees should accompany the entry forms.
- TEACHERS should refrain from entering a huge group of candidates that play the same piece over and over on the same instrument. This is simply annoying. Take some time and find appropriate pieces for candidates. It keeps the spirit and the mind active.

NOTE: This section is only for SOLO items. For duets (BEGINNERS), trios etc. please see the sessions for those options in this booklet.




SESSION: A2 MUSIC OF THE BAROQUE ERA


- J This session focus on ALL MUSIC GRADES AND ALL SOLO INSTRUMENTS EXCEPT PIPE ORGAN.
- Entrants ARE NOT REQUIRED TO INCLUDE A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC WITH THE ENTRY FORM, BUT ARE REMINDED TO SUBMIT A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC TO THE ADJUDICATOR SECRETARY ON THE DAY OF PERFORMANCE. This copy may not be returned.
- Candidates to provide their own instruments (other than piano).
- Candidates to provide their own accompanists (if necessary).
- ♫ Maximum time limit per piece: 5 minutes
- Choice of work: Own choice. Composers for this period are limited to: J.S. Bach, Handel, Scarlatti, Purcell or any of their contemporaries.

<u>Three (3)</u> pieces may be submitted per instrument but candidates are reminded that it should be done on three separate entry forms and the appropriate entry fees should accompany the entry forms. <u>A candidate may perform more than once in this session but it</u> <u>should be on different instruments</u>. Thus, candidate (x) may enter three pieces for piano, three pieces for violin, three pieces for flute etc.

NOTE: THE SAME PIECES ENTERED FOR THIS SESSION CANNOT BE ENTERED AGAIN FOR THE COMPETITIVE SESSION.







- This session focus on <u>ALL MUSIC GRADES AND ALL SOLO INSTRUMENTS.</u>

A candidate may perform more than once in this session but is should be on different instruments. Thus candidate (x) may enter two pieces for piano, two pieces for violin, two pieces for flute etc.

- Candidates to provide their own instruments (other than piano).4. Candidates to provide their own accompanists (if necessary).
- Maximum time limit per piece: 10 minutes
- Choice of work: Own choice. Composers for this period are limited to: Chopin, Brahms, Schubert, Schumann, Mendelssohn, Liszt, Faure, Grieg, Wagner or any of their contemporaries.

<u>THREE (3)</u> pieces may be submitted per instrument but candidates are reminded that it should be done on two separate entry forms and the appropriate entry fees should accompany the entry forms. A candidate may perform more than once in this session but is should be on different instruments. Thus candidate (x) may enter two pieces for piano, two pieces for violin, two pieces for flute etc.

<u>THREE (3)</u> pieces may be submitted per instrument but candidates are reminded that it should be done on two separate entry forms and the appropriate entry fees should accompany the entry forms. A candidate may perform more than once in this session but is should be on different instruments. Thus, candidate (x) may enter two pieces for piano, two pieces for violin, two pieces for flute etc.

SESSION: A6

COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION SESSION

This session is open for Primary and High Schools as well as Tertiary Students

This unique category was first tested in 2016 and with astonishing results.

This session is particularly helpful for both teachers and music students preparing for the annual external and internal music examinations. It is an extremely good platform to perform the pieces in the presence of an expert and sometimes specialist adjudicator/examiner. Depending on the entries received for this session we might have a panel of adjudicators. Teachers are welcome to indicate on the entry form the sections they wish to be tested. Generally, it is only scales and pieces that are tested, but sight-reading and aural tests can also be tested. FULL test will include a formal examination which includes all of the tests. The comments of the adjudicator are extremely important in order to fix mistakes not noticed before. We trust that this session will be even bigger and better in 2019.

GENERAL

- This session is for all candidates performing the Graded examinations of ABRSM, UNISA, TRINITY etc, <u>BUT NOT</u> <u>RESTRICTED TO THESE EXAMINATION BODIES.</u>
- Candidates to perform a balanced program of three (3) pieces on the same instrument. <u>TAKE NOTE</u>: UNISA candidates are allowed to perform four (4) pieces as a programme.
- Candidates to perform their program in one sitting.
- The session is open for music grades 1 − 8 AS WELL AS FOR TERTIARY STUDENTS.
- ♫ The session is open for any solo instrument except pipe organ.
- Candidates are free to perform more than one program but can only do so if the instruments are other than the 1st instrument.

For example:

Joan of Arc – Piano Grade 3	-	One sitting
Joan of Arc – Flute Grade 6	-	One sitting
Joan of Arc – Violin Grade 8	-	One sitting

In such a case the candidate can perform each program separately according to the time table for this session. **REMINDER:** EACH SITTING MUST CONSIST OF A BALANCED PROGRAM OF THREE (3) PIECES. All three pieces presented cannot be presented coming from the Baroque period etc. It should represent a balanced spread of the style periods.

- Candidates are required to complete only ONE entry form for ONE SITTING but should complete another entry form should they wish to enter for more than one instrument.
- Please see the RATES on page 8 & 9 for the entry fee per sitting.
- *Candidates will receive a diploma for the complete sitting and feedback for every piece that they perform.*
- By the time the entry forms are submitted, candidates are requested to insert the names of the composers as well as the names of the pieces on the entry form. This information will appear on the diploma.
- Time allocation per sitting will be calculated according to the music grade and will be stipulated on the final program including the time given to adjudicators to write their comments.
- Entrants ARE NOT REQUIRED TO INCLUDE A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC WITH THE ENTRY FORM, BUT ARE REMINDED TO SUBMIT A COPY OF THEIR MUSIC TO THE ADJUDICATOR SECRETARY ON THE DAY OF PERFORMANCE. This copy may not be returned.



INTRODUCTION

This competition is designed in three (3) different categories:

- 1. Primary Schools
- 2. High Schools
- 3. Tertiary Students/Adults

The rules for all categories are the same.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

Applications must consist of the following:

- ✓ Completed Application Form
- ✓ Photocopy of your birth certificate, passport, or driver's license.
- ✓ Proof of your entry fee.

<u>GENERAL</u>

- > Contestants should be dressed appropriately.
- > A copy of the sheet music to be submitted to the adjudicator on the day of performance.
- > Memorisation is not required in any of the three (3) categories
- > The competition is open for all members of the violin family: Violin, Viola, Cello & Double Bass
- > The competition is only open to SOLOISTS. No duets or any other combination.
- Contestants should familiarize themselves with the repertoire of their instrument and especially with the specific category they entered.
- Contestants at High School and Tertiary/Adult level are <u>NOT EXPECTED</u> to perform complete Sonatas or Concertos. Single movements of these advanced works are acceptable. Where a movement of a concerto is performed, backing tracks are allowed (but MUST be of a very good/high quality) and/or piano arrangements thereof as accompaniment.
- Winners are allowed to play the same piece of the actual adjudication during the Prestige Concert.
- No piece must exceed the time limit of 10 minutes. <u>Special permission must be obtained from the festival office should your piece exceed this limit.</u>

EXTREMELY IMPORTANT This is a professional COMPETITION and here we do not follow the liberties as in other instrumental categories as far as beginners (young and/or old) are concerned. If you enter in Category 2 – High Schools then it will be assumed that you are on that level. The same for the other two categories. To make things VERY CLEAR TO EVERYBODY the following example. If you enter in category 3 – Tertiary Students/Adults then you should know your instrument (including technique) and its repertoire very well. You will be expected to perform repertoire of advanced level. You CANNOT enter as a student/adult and expect to play like primary school learners. **YOU WILL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED!!!! Entry fees will NOT BE returned! PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU READ AND UNDERSTAND all details here very carefully. If in doubt, please contact our office at: info@srvartsfest.co.za**

PIANO ACCOMPANIMENT

Soloists to provide their own accompaniment (a piano is provided by the festival) and accompanist. If no accompanist is available, candidates are free to contact the festival office via email for assistance in this regard.

DATE & TIME

This competition will take place within the two weeks of the Arts & Culture Festival. Depending on the number of entries received, a specific day and time will be communicated to all participants. The competition will be held during the day. No evening performances are scheduled for this competition.



WINNERS

Winners of the three categories will be expected to perform at the Prestige concert of the festival which is held on Saturday 7th September 2019, 10:00 at Kirkwood High School.

PRIZES

- There is only ONE winner in each category. There will be no 2nd and/or 3rd place.
- All participants will receive a diploma.



This session is open for the combination of instrumentalists according to the section title. ٦

Jucts TRISS QUARTET

- 5 Candidates may perform on any instrument of their choice (except organ) and must provide their own instruments if the instrument is not a piano.
- Candidates will be assessed as an ensemble and not as individuals. 5
- 5 A diploma will be issued to each candidate.
- 5 This session is intended for candidates and not for a candidate/s together with their teacher.
- 5 Copies of all performance works must be submitted to the adjudicator secretary and may not be returned.
- 5 Candidates must note that the Copyright Act 98 of 1978, as amended, strictly prohibits the photocopying of sheet music without written permission form the publisher.
- 5 Candidates may use any edition.
- 5 Candidates are free to perform from any period: Baroque, Classical, Romantic, and Modern.
- 5 Page turners are allowed but must not be the teacher of candidates.
- 5 Choice of work: Own choice.
- TWO (2) items per candidate candidate, such a candidate Maximum time limit: 10 minutes 5 **TWO (2)** items per candidate are permitted, BUT where a candidate performed as a duet, or accompanist to another candidate, such a candidate may enter more than twice.

GUIDE:

C2 - TRIOS:

Here the possibilities are also almost endless. Trio Sonatas, Piano Trio (piano, violin and cello), String Trio (violin, viola and cello), Flute, Viola and Harp, Jazz trio, Clarinet-violin-piano trio, Clarinet-violoncello and piano, Power Trios (bass guitar, drum kit), Horn Trio (Violin, Horn and Piano) etc.

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C3 - QUARTETS:

String Quartets (2 Violins, a viola and cello), sometimes also: Violin, Viola, Cello and Double Bass. Piano Quartet: Violin, Viola, Cello and Piano Wind Quartet: Wind, Violin, Viola and Cello Woodwind Quartet: Flute, Oboe, Clarinet and Bassoon


Saxophone Quartet: featuring 4 of the same instruments – Soprano, Alto, Tenor and Baritone Sax

C4 - QUINTETS

Wind Quintet (Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon and Horn) Brass Quintet (2 Trumpets, Horn, Trombone and Tuba) Piano Quintet (2 Violins, Viola, Cello + any other instrument such as Piano, clarinet, oboe etc.) NOTE: Other variations are possible. Teachers should use their own discretion.

Jazz Quintet – Alto Saxophone, Trumpet, Piano, Bass, Drums (The Greatest Concert Ever – Charlie Parker, 1953)

String Quintet – As an extension to the string quartet, a string quintet includes a 5th string instrument, usually a 2nd viola (a so-called "viola quintet), or a second cello (a "cello quintet"), or occasionally a double bass.
